Each year the Denver Area Panhellenic (DAP) awards scholarship funding to sorority collegians and alumnae with ties to Colorado. Undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate women who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, volunteerism and meaningful participation in sorority activities are encouraged to apply. **Two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded for the 2017-2018 academic year.** Applications are due March 3, 2017. Award announcements will be made in April. Scholarship recipients and a guest are invited to the Denver Area Panhellenic Awards Luncheon held in Lakewood, Colorado on April 29, 2017.

DAP is a member run organization comprised of delegates representing National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) member organization alumnae chapters in the Denver Metro Area of Colorado. For over ninety years, the purpose of DAP has been: to inform fraternity women of current trends; to promote the fraternity system; to improve the Panhellenic image; and to stimulate a continuing interest in Panhellenic affairs.

- I am either a resident of Colorado attending an accredited in-state or out-of-state school, or an out-of-state student attending an accredited Colorado school.
- I am enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program for the 2017-2018 academic year.
- I agree to refund DAP the total amount of this scholarship should I withdraw from school during the 2017-2018 academic year.
- I was not previously awarded a DAP Scholarship.
